## 4 REQUIRED TOOLS

- Clamps



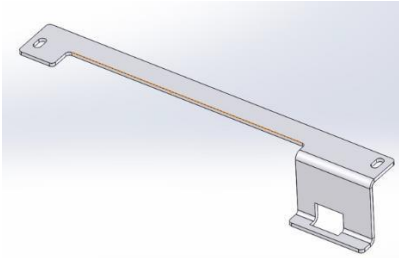
- Torx Screwdriver #10



## 4 PIECES INCLUDED IN THE SET

---

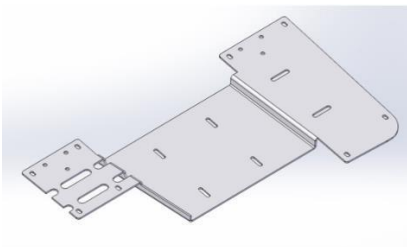
- Closure striker



- Glove compartment door



- Equipment mounting plate (fixed to the door)



- Compartment retaining wire



## 5 PREPARING THE INSTALLATION

---

In order to proceed with the installation, some parts must be removed. The next steps will allow you to remove the required parts to prepare for the installation of your new glove compartment.

**\*\*\* Keep all hardware removed as it will be reused for the installation of the new glove compartment. Pack and store the remaining hardware, it will be useful to replace the original glove compartment. \*\*\***

1. Disengage the side portions of the original glove compartment to allow it to tilt downward.

2. Remove the glove compartment retaining cable by disengaging it from the retaining slot.



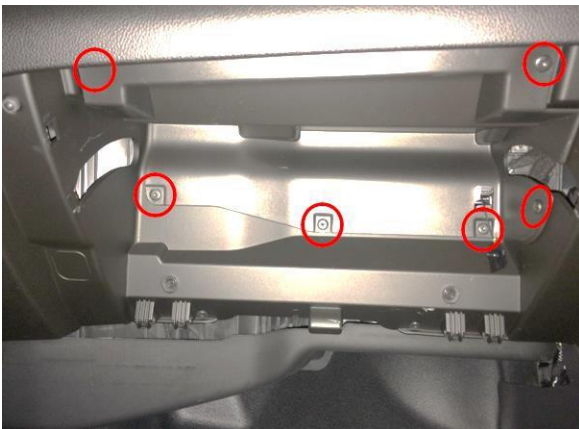
*Retaining slot disengagement*

- Using pliers, remove the centre pivot of the two hinges from the door, and remove the door.



*Door Removal*

- Remove the liner from the bottom of the glove compartment by removing the 6 screws retaining it.



*Removing trim*

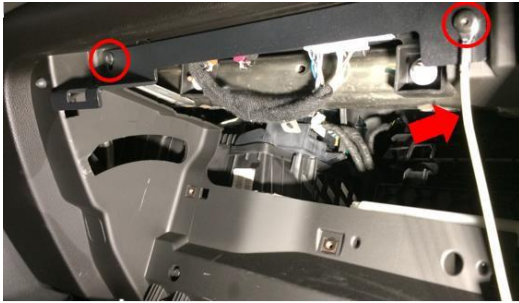


## 6 GLOVE COMPARTMENT INSTALLATION

---

The following steps will guide you through the installation of the new glove compartment in the vehicle.

1. Install the compartment retaining striker by using the 2 top screws, as shown in the photo, taking care to attach the retaining cable to the right screw:



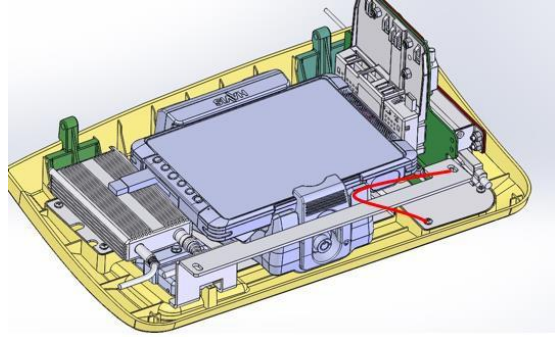
*Retaining striker and cable installation*

2. Install the new glove compartment door by reinstalling the 2 hinge pivots removed previously.

3. Attach the retaining cable to the location shown in the photo.
